

**PROCEDURES FOR
APPLICATION TO BECOME A MEMBER LEAGUE OF THE
SOUTH CAROLINA AMATEUR SOCCER ASSOCIATION (SCASA)**

(Updated: October 2020)

The SCASA is the South Carolina state member of the United States Adult Soccer Association (USASA).

By joining SCASA and maintaining its position of “good standing”, a Member League will have the benefits available to all sanctioned Member Leagues, including access to United States Soccer Federation (USSF) referees and insurance (insurance details are available under different cover).

As per the SCASA Bylaws 211-214 a League desiring to become a member must:

- 1) Submit a scan copy of the application (attached) requesting admission, addressed to:

- 2) For private leagues: include with the application copies of its charter or articles of incorporation, bylaws, rules, regulations, any rules of play, and other governing documents appropriate to understanding the structure and activities of the organization.

For leagues operated through local, city, county, or state departments of recreation or other government entities, include any documents concerning the league organization, management, and rules.
- 3) Ascertain that the League does not discriminate against any potential participants, including players, coaches, and volunteers on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.
- 4) As stated in SCASA Bylaw 213, section 2: “Each Member League shall retain its own autonomy except as otherwise provided in the SCASA bylaws”.

Upon admission as a Member, a League agrees to:

- 1) Allow only players registered with SCASA for the current seasonal year (September 1 – August 31) to play in league games. Players must prove their valid registration status with the game referee before entering a game by showing either a SCASA team roster with their photographs or their SCASA player passes.
- 2) Enforce necessary disciplinary actions.
- 3) Enforce all suspensions, including outstanding suspensions against individuals (players, coaches, volunteers, administrators) who may have received such suspensions from other Member Leagues, SCASA, USASA, USSF, or FIFA.
- 4) The term of membership of the Member League is for one seasonal year, from September 1 2020 through August 31 2021. Membership automatically renews each seasonal year as long as the Member remains in good standing with SCASA.

- 5) Membership in SCASA is not transferable or assignable. Membership terminates when SCASA dissolves, the Member League dissolves, the Individual Member dies, or as provided under the SCASA bylaws.
- 6) With the consent of the Board of Directors, a Member League may change its organizational structure without losing its membership in SCASA.
- 7) To the extent consistent with applicable law, comply with the bylaws of SCASA and the Federation.
- 8) To the extent consistent with applicable law, comply with policies and requirements of SCASA with respect to SCASA's internal operations and the administration of SCASA programs.
- 9) Submit to SCASA any amendment to its charter or articles of incorporation, bylaws, rules, and regulations not later than 60 days prior to the beginning of the seasonal year.

Other Information

- 1) Each Member League is encouraged to participate in SCASA functions and meetings.
- 2) The Member League is entitled to vote at State Council Annual General Meetings. A League shall have the following number of total votes:
 - 0 - 200 players: 1 vote
 - 201 - 400 players: 2 votes, total
 - 401 - 600 players: 3 votes, total
 - 601 - 800 players: 4 votes, total
 - 801 or more : 5 votes, total
- 3) Each Member League is entitled to at least one voting position on the SCASA Board of Directors.
